## Description

Steps to reproduce:

- 1. Create an empty project
- 2. Change the project's background color to black
- 3. Create a composer
- 4. Add a map item and make sure its background color is black (it should be by default)
- 5. Extend the map item's height and width to fully cover the map sheet
- 6. Export the sheet to a PNG image
- 7. Open the exported PNG image with Gimp, or Photoshop, and zoom in until pixels are large blocks and go to the very bottom of the image, you'll notice a non-black line at the very bottom (light gray)

That's a problem that can be irritating when exporting maps, see attached example (last line is white, it shouldn't be)
