<p>It would be a nice touch if QgsFieldExpressionWidget showed the expression row in a different font style (eg italic), or a different color, so that it's differentiated from the layer's columns. Otherwise it's a little confusing when the currently selected column appears twice in the list - one for the column, and once at the end for the expression value.</p>
