<p>Back in March when the plugin server was moving to a new host, Francesco P. Lovergine filed <a href="#">Debian Bug #742688</a> in which he reported problems updating the plugins.</p> <p>The problem was tracked down to <a href="http://plugins.qgis.org/plugins/plugins.xml">http://plugins.qgis.org/plugins/plugins.xml</a> being slow and QGIS giving up the download too soon.</p> <p>He suggests to increase the timeout to better handle situations like these.</p> <p>Better diagnostics why the plugins cannot be updated/installed would also be appreciated as well as more redundancy in support infrastructure.</p> <p>I'm forwarding this request as suggested by Alex Mandel in the <a href="#">mailinglist thread</a>.</p>
