<p>It would be handy to have replace variable in QgsExpression like we have normally in SQL type engines. For example:</p> <pre>exp = QgsExpression('"person" = @name') exp.bind('name', "Woo")</pre> <p>This would change the expression to be:</p> <pre>"person" = 'Woo'</pre> <p>The difference is these are added at parse time not on evaluate.</p> <p>A more simple Python API could be:</p> <pre>exp = QgsExpression('"person" = @name', name="Woo")</pre>
