Description It would be nice to be able to change outline and fill colors of the Composers Picture Items. This would be possible for "prepared" SVGs, just like in the map canvas layer symbols. This would allow adjusting the pictures colors (e.g. North Arrows) to the current map color set, without the need to create a new SVG for it.
