<p>Preferences Menu &gt; Options &gt; Renderer tab</p> <p>On Mac OSX, all the options in "Renderer behavior" group are greyed. That includes options like "By default new layers added to the map should be displayed", "Enable back buffer" and "Use render caching where possible to speed up redraws".</p> <p>That doesn't help to better speed-up the rendering of the layers.</p> <p>I don't have master installed but this happens at least on 2.2 and 2.0.</p>
