<p>steps:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">+ create a project and add a raster layer+ duplicate the layer+ in the duplicate layer change manually (for whatever reason) the CRS to a different one+ save the project <p>starting from now when using certain tools (like "warp") a warning will pop up</p> <p><i>Layers do not all use the same CRS.</i> <i>This can cause unexpected results.</i> <i>Do you want to continue?</i></p> <p>problem is that for tools that have only 1 input file does not make sense at all...</p>
