<ul style="list-style-type: none">- create a VF, decimal (2 decimal places) with the \$area function- make categorized symbology using this field- problem 1: the categories do not have the right number of decimal places but a lot more- problem 2: the symbology is ok under Linux, while under Windows does not (all features same color) [of course I used the very same vector layer for tests]
