The [[PostGIS]] layer parameter CONNECTION is wrongly written into the mapfile. There are used only the single quotes and it causes a crash when loading mapfile by mapserver. Example: <pre>CONNECTION 'host=localhost user='postgres' password=postgres dbname='voda_v_krajine_</pre>
