<b>Description</b>		
<p>Is it possible to add an "Eraser/rubber tool" like the Rubber tool in e.g. "Paint" or the Eraser tool in Gimp (which erases to background with a brush)?</p> <p>Such a tool would be very convenient when using QGIS on a tablet (Windows 8.1 or Android) - just activating the Eraser tool and use the finger (or pen) to delete parts of a line.</p> <p>In Inkscape the Eraser tool erase existing path (i.e. the whole feature/object/item) when "drawing" a line crossing the feature (but here the entire feature is deleted). It would be preferable to be able to delete just a part of it with a "brush" navigated with your finger or pen on the tablet screen. However, also deleting features just by touching them (or drawing a crossing line) would be an improvement on a tablet without clicking the select tool, selecting the feature and then hitting the delete icon. Precise selection (of tools/icons and features) are more difficult and more time-consuming on a 8" screen than on a computer with mouse and 24" screen...</p>
