It seems that that string is generated calling QVariant::typeName which returns a string representation of the QVariant instance.</p> <p>The attributes are used to build the layer properties dialog in QWC and probably other clients, of course we can do a search/replace in the client but I wonder if doing it in the server would be a better approach.</p>
