<p>I just experienced a crash while saving a map. I opened the map, removed a few layers, and then saved resulting in the crash. I can't be certain but I suspect this is related to one of the deleted layers being used for Atlas generation. The crash occurred repeatedly until I also deleted the composer map that used the Atlas feature layer in question. This resulted in the document saving as expected with no corruption.</p> <p>After each crash, the saved map document was corrupted and unusable. Fortunately, I was working from a copy and was able to restore the original.</p>
