I tried to import in QGIS a view with a PostGIS geometry column, which data are obtained from a second db (using dblink in Postgres). It works through the normal 'Add PostGIS layer', not through DB Manager. <pre>CREATE OR REPLACE VIEW my_view AS SELECT id, geomfromtext('POINT(' x_coo ' ' y_coo ')', 3003) FROM dblink('host=127.0.0.1 port=5432 dbname=xxx user=xxx password=xxx', 'SELECT id, x_coo, y_coo FROM my_table;') AS m (id numeric, x_coo numeric, y_coo numeric);</pre>
