<p>For some reason many floating point number spin boxes use some kind of "padding" events - it is not possible to delete and enter other value by hand, as it constantly gets padded to specified formatting.</p> <p>Steps to reproduce:</p> <p>Open a print composer;</p> <p>Add any element;</p> <p>Open element properties and choose "Position and Size";</p> <p>Try to position element at coordinates X: 21.319 Y: 7.503</p> <p>Observe how clever editing technique has to be used to enter value.</p>
