<p>In the latest qgis server versions if a feature has many nodes then modifying it or adding new one will fail if it has many nodes.</p> <p>Errors: ERROR: 1 geometries not changed.</p> <p>Provider errors:</p> <p>empty response</p> <p>Simplified/generalized versions of the same feature will be saved with no problems.</p> <p>It seems it is not a wfs client issue as the same feature will edit with no problems if published with geoserver.</p> <p>I can't remember to have seen this issue in older qgis/server releases, but as I'm not 100% sure I'm not tagging this as a blocker.</p>
