Using qgis desktop, qgis server 2.4 on fedora, I can launch GetCapabilities request but it contains no layers.

.qgs contains relative path for data source (<datasource>./echantillonage.shp</datasource>) I manually edit .qgs so I can set an absolute path instead a relative path for datasource ( <datasource>/opt/geodata/echantillonage.shp</datasource>)and GetCapabilities returns the layers.

But as soon I edit my project in qgis desktop and save it, It overwrites my modification and re-create relative paths and the WMS still contains no layers
