<p>If I try to define a filter on a File GDB layer, the "Values" window shows values from the wrong field. This appears to happen whether I click on "Sample" or "All". It looks like it is taking the corresponding value from the first field in the table, rather than from the column I have selected.</p> <p>This bug doesn't affect my ability to filter - I can still set the filter properly by manually typing in the filter values. It looks like only the population of the "Values" list is affected. Based on my testing, this only affects File GDB layers.</p> <p>I'm using QGIS 2.6 newly downloaded from OSGeo4W.</p> <p>Steps to reproduce:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1 - Open a File GDB feature class in QGIS2 - Open Layer Properties dialog3 - Select Query Builder to define a layer filter4 - Select a field other than the first field in the list5 - Click on "Sample" or "All" in the Values box
