<p>QGIS 2.4, 2.6 and master, working with PostGIS layers.</p> <p>I can save styles to and restore from Local database (which I assume is a local SQLite DB?)</p> <p>However, if I save a style to the datasource database, a record is created in public.layer_styles BUT if I try to restore default style the response is 'Style not found in database'.</p> <p>Also when I open the layer the style is not applied.</p> <p>And when I choose Load style -> from Datasource database, nothing is listed in 'styles related to the layer' and all the other styles EXCEPT the one(s) I want are listed in 'other styles on [sic] the database' i.e. the one(s) I want have been detected and filtered out.</p>
