<p>When exporting Atlas features, if an attribute field used to name the output file has a slash in it, the export fails. It appears the export tool interprets the slash in the attribute data as a directory name. When it can't find the directory, it errors out.</p> <p>Steps to reproduce:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1 - Create a set of features for Atlas generation2 - Set the export file name to be based on one of the attribute fields3 - Ensure that one of the features includes a slash (/) in the attribute data4 - Export <p>Expected behavior:</p> <p>Either the exporter should automatically substitute the slash with another character (e.g. '-' or a space), or the user should be presented with a choice of substitute characters. At a minimum, a warning should alert the user that the export may be affected.</p> <p>Current workaround:</p> <p>Use the replace() string function to define a custom replacement in the output filename. (e.g. replace("name", '/', '-'))</p>
