Shouldn't it be red *until* you have put something in it? The field is required, so an empty field is 'wrong'. Maybe it should have a "Required" placeholder text, something that used to be avoided <u>until Qt 4.7 became the minimum requirement for QGIS</u>. At least that would be clear in meaning.

Before, users would check the checkbox and not enter a field or expression, thereby resulting in no labeling and much worse confusion. So, indicating that the field is required (somehow) is important.
