<p>A number of users are having problems with older version of a plugin in their home dir (this happens especially often with Processing) masking the system one.</p> <p>IMHO the behaviour is correct, but the user should be warned (e.g. "You are using an older version of a plugin, a new one is available on your system: do you want to remove the old one?").</p>
