| <p>Steps to reproduce:</p> <p>Open two PostGIS linestring layers in a map document</p> <p>Select a line feature from one layer</p> <p>Click the 'Copy Features' button on the Editing toolbar</p> <p>Turn on editing on the other layer</p> <p>Paste into the other layer using the 'Paste Features' button on the Editing toolbar</p> <p>Click the 'Deselect Features from All Layers' button on the Attributes toolbar</p> <p>What happens:</p> <p>Although editing is still active on the layer, the GUI editing button toggles, making it appear as if editing has been turned off and there are no edits to save.</p> <p>Tested using latest nightly from OSGeo4W. Also occurs in 2.6.1.</p> | | |
