<p>I'm running QGIS 2.6.0-Brighton under Mac OS X 10.9.5 on a Mac Mini (late 2009) 2.26 GHz Intel Core 2 Duo with 4 GB RAM.</p> <p>Settings &gt; Configure Shortcuts... will not let me set a shortcut which includes a Cmd key.</p> <p>When I click on the "Change" button, which changes to "Input", the button title displays</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Ctrl- when the Cmd key is held</li><li>Alt- when the Option key is held</li><li>Meta- when the Ctrl key is held.</li></ul> <p>followed by whatever key I'm also holding down.</p> <p>Attempt to set, for example, Cmd-L result in just L being set.</p> <p>The standard Keyboard Viewer shows the correct keys - Cmd, Opt(Alt) &amp; Ctrl so OS X is "seeing" the right keys.</p> <p>Work-around: I just used Opt.</p> <p>But would be nice to be able to assign Cmd- shortcuts...</p> <p>Truly wonderful software by the way!</p> <p>--</p> <p>Garth Fletcher</p>
