<p>Hi,</p> <p>Great feature than the ability to attribute multiple styles to a layer in a project.</p> <p>When in layer properties > Style, you load an existing style (from file or DB), I think it'll be better if this style was appended to the list of existing styles (with its registered name) and even set active instead of overwriting the active one.</p> <p>Now, to avoid overwriting previous style, you need to create a new ("useless") style, set it active and then load the one you are expecting.</p> <p>This process can be improved with the above proposal.</p>
