<p>Exporting attribute table from PostGIS layers to CSV does not work with a layer containing several thousand record and/or column named "ID".</p> <p>One suitable option for solving this would be to allow for more export formats than just shape in DbManager.</p> <p>Furthermore, shape-format is limited in possible amount of data (2GB) and length of column names so that in addition to CSV, something SQLite-ish would be useful for export (or a generic GDAL solution).</p> <p>For discussion see: http://lists.osgeo.org/pipermail/qgis-developer/2015-January/036554.html</p>
