<p>Hi,</p> <p>I have noticed a problem in successive versions of QGIS (and also on version 2.6):</p> <p>When editing a value of an attribute in an attribute table, the completed edit doesn't always display after the edit. Only when you save the table, do your attribute edits become visible.</p> <p>The same behaviour is observed when using the field calculator:</p> <p>After calculating the values of an attribute to be a certain output, the edited values don't look like they have changed until the table is saved.</p> <p>There appears to be an attribute refresh problem and this is very annoying when you are dealing with a large number of sorted records in a table.</p> <p>It also damages the credibility of QGIS by creating doubt over its' data handling integrity.</p> <p>It would be great if this issue could be addressed promptly as it is a long-standing issue.</p>
