<p>Select layers in TOC and click on any button that removes a layer from the project.</p> <p>You get a message box "Remove x legend entries?". click Yes.</p> <p>Then, when in QGIS<2.4, the status bar showed a message like "x legend entries removed", in QGIS Master and Brighton status bar shows "Remove x legend entries ?". It still asks the question instead of showing the result.</p> <p>This is a bit confusing the first time you got, doubting if you had removed or not the layers.</p> <p>It's not a huge blocking feature but as it worked in earlier releases...</p> <p>Seen on windows 7, QGIS 64 bits 2.6 and master 47ffa70</p>
