Description		
<p>In case of a value relation widget there is the option to select multiple values. QGIS then stores them in a text column with curly brackets and commas as a separator.</p> <p>Like: {1,3,7}</p> <p>QGIS server should then resolve these values, replace the codes with their text representation and output them eg. as: Meier,Müller,Schmid</p> <p>Currently, QGIS server returns the raw values like {1,3,7}. In case of only a single value, the output is fine.</p>		
<p>I also noticed that when resolving value relations, QGIS server always adds round parenthesis around the value, which wasn't the case before. These parentheses should be removed.</p>
