<p>Hi,</p> <p>I get following error in QGIS, when I try to connect with a NOSUPERUSER user to a postgis database:</p> <p>ERROR: function postgis_version() does not exist at character 8 HINT: No function matches the given name and argument types. You might need to add explicit type casts. STATEMENT: SELECT postgis_version()</p> <p>The problem was, that I didn't grant create/usage rights for the user to the public schema. The same message seems to appear, if the database is not spatially enabled.</p> <p>It would be helpful to improve the error message.</p> <p>Regards Otto</p>
