Below is the crash information from system log:</p> <p>qgis<sup>17131</sup>: segfault at 1c8 ip 00007f9d2d6edb5e sp 00007fff42f23198 error 4 in libQtGui.so.4.8.6[7f9d2d4e5000+aa2000]</p> <p>However, if I open as 'gksudo qgis', everything seems fine.</p>
