<p>The idea is to add a "multiple input" option for all data types, including attribute columns.</p> <p>For example, for some tools, it would be helpful to have a way to specify a list of attributes which should be analyzed. Currently, it seems like the only work-around is to force the user to type a list into a text input field.</p>
