You get the list of print composers.</p> <p>Without closing this dialog, open an existing project (that doesn't contain print composer) or a new empty one</p> <p>The print composers from the first project are still listed in the composer manager.</p> <p>If you don't pay attention and try to open one of them, QGIS crashes.</p> <p>tested on windows8, osgeo4w 32bits, qgis 2.8.1 and 2.9</p>
