Description <p>I have created a new group in Style Manager and populated it with some styles. When I filter the symbols in my group using the filter box, the results return matches from all ungrouped and grouped styles, even styles that are assigned to a different group than the one I'm looking at. The filter should operate only on the group selected.</p> <p>Steps to reproduce:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Open Style Manager2) Create a new group3) Create a new line style called "test road"4) Assign "test road" to the new group5) Select the new group6) In the filter box type "road" <p>The results include road styles from the ungrouped styles as well as any matches from other groups. Should only show "test road" since this is the only match in the new group.</p>
