| <p>It would be nice to be able to save the absolute path to the images you use in a composer, and especially (more needed) a composer template.</p> <p>This would make it possible to save a standard template on a shared directory, and be able to let it use by all the QGIS-users in all of their projects. In this way they don't have to worry about the format, logo's, even if the company-logo changes; you just change one file!</p> <p>Now it is always a relative path in the .qpt-file. So if you change the place of you qgs-project, or you use a project in another directory, loading the template gives you a 'red cross', the link is not found anymore due to the fact it's a relative link..</p> <p>Thanx!</p> | | |
