<p>Given a directory based file format (like U.S. Census TIGER or FileGDB/OpenFileGDB) has moved in the file system and the project is reopened, QGIS asks for new location.</p> <p>Currently this dialog asks only for files (which is not suitable for directory based file formats) and insists in choosing a file.</p> <p>A proper solution would be, that new file location dialog detects directory based file format and offers to choose a folder.</p> <p>(Workaround: Meanwhile, one can to choose a file (incl. path) and manually delete the file immediately in the dialog).</p>
