<p>Playing with cusomization here: saving a QGIS setup which only can open shape file.</p> <p>I saved the setup as 'minimalshape' (as I did not know which extension was needed).</p> <p>Trying to open that file again via 'open customization file', it was not visible anymore (because the file-filter for the dialog is .ini and there is no option for 'all files')</p> <p>Proposed fixes(?):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- add .ini when the user does not add it him/herself ot a config file- add '(.ini)' to the visible string in the 'filter dropdown' in the file browser?- maybe also add a 'all files' as file filter so at least I can see the file I just saved
