<p>When uninstalling QGIS 2.8.2 Wien on a Windows 7 x64 OS, the entry in Add/Remove Programs is not deleted. This is because the associated registry entry "HKLM\\software\\microsoft\\windows\\currentversion\\uninstall\\QGIS Wien" is not deleted.</p> <p>This is not a Problem because it is easy to do this manually or by a Batch file but i wanted you to know this little issue.</p> <p>And while looking at this, you may also add the "DisplayVersion"-Registry-Value too. =)</p> <p>Another Thing i noticed is that the Desktop-Shortcuts are named differently in x86 and x64 installer. I.E:</p> <p>OSGeo4W (x86) and OSGeo4W Shell (x64) MSYS Shell (x86) and MSYS (x64)</p>
