In QGIS 1.9 there is a visual feedback of the movement but not of the snapping itself.</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Ofwyu64rOsQ</p> <p>In this clip the blue polygon border shows the movement of the geometry but the pink cross for snapping is missing.</p> <p>Doing the same in QGIS 2.9.0-Master I don't have any visual feedback of the movement and the snapping.</p>
