<p>Hi !</p> <p>The "Select by location" tool does not work with layers with different CRS.</p> <p>Currently, there's no warning message, the selection simply doesn't work (I didn't test, but it probably does the computation as if the CRS was the same for the two layers).</p> <p>Since QGIS allows on the fly reprojection, I think this limitation should not exist.</p> <p>Best,</p> <p>Olivier</p>
