### Description

I'll describe this step by step.

- 1. I want to simplify the geometries in a vector layer (ESRI Shape).
- 2. I click Vector: Geometry Tools: Simplify Geometries...
- 3. I select the vector layer in the drop down.
- 4. Without setting anything else I click OK.
  - QGIS responds with a message box:

"Currently QGIS doesn't allow simultaneous access from different threads to the same datasource. Make sure your layer's attribute tables are close. Continue?"

- 5. I click the No button.
- 6. I check the "Save to new file" and select my new output file.
- 7. The state of the OK button is still disabled even though I have provided a valid output.

The same happens when I select an output in step 4, but the file I selected was locked by another program in which case QGIS complains. I then select a valid output instead but the OK button stays disabled.
