<p>Hi QGIS. There are no Null values entered for field1 or field2 (Spatialite layer). Sorting on field1 in the attribute table produces a set of Null values for field1, then sorting on field2 removes the Null values from field1 but introduces them to field2. This behaviour is not happening for QGIS 2.8.
