<b>Description</b>  I would like an easy way to update some points when I am given longitude / latitude points rather than doing a CSV load which is a slower update method. I have used the "Numerical Digitize" plugin which was a good way of moving points, but it does not work at the moment with moving a point to a long / lat.  If there is another way that I can do this same location update task then that would be great - I might be missing something. It would be nice to see that "Numerical Digitize" tool type operation in the main build.
