<p>Hi,</p> <p>While exporting a print composer to image, a world file associated to a composerMap placed on a page other than the first is currently useless. This can puzzle the user (as doc says nothing about this limitation). Since #6985 offers the user an option to choose for which composerMap a world file should be created, I think the world file should take into account the page/position of the composerMap (in case of multipage composer).</p> <p>And the world file name should be the same as the exported page containing the related composerMap.</p>
