<p>Although there is a setting in the project properties stating that relative paths must be used, it is not possible for photos or files, like in the forms widgets.</p> <p>This is not consistent (relative paths can be used for resources like svg's for example) and seems to be a rather common problem in QGIS, according to other open tickets. This is especially a difficulty when sharing a project between several users.</p>
