<p>Not sure if this is intended or a bug. But when I have two layers with different CRSs in a project, toggling them in the layer list will automatically enable on-the-fly CRS transformation, even though I have specifically set it not to, in the project settings.</p>

Restarting QGIS or creating a new project doesn't change anything to this behavior here. Toggling on-the-fly takes immediate effect, and toggling layers with on-the-fly activated or not, still causes this effect.

You need to set your the OTF projection OFF:

From Settings > Options > CRS: select Do not enable 'on the fly' reprojection.

Restart your QGIS and things should work as expected.
