<p>Hi people,</p> <p>I use QGIS 2.10.1</p> <p>Since a few years I have to record the landuse for an area. As the areas don't change much I have just archived the shape file from the previous year with a different filename. Afterwards I marked the individual features and updated the current use in the attribute table. In case of geometry changes I used "split feature" or "merge feature".</p> <p>Until now that worked flawlessly!</p> <p>now I find that after enabling "show feature count" in the legend, that the display feature number is wrong (for 107 "real" features, I get 138).
