<p>Ubuntu Vivid, qgis master from debian-nightly. The qgis.desktop file (attached) wants to execute /usr/share/qgis:</p> <pre>TryExec=/usr/bin/qgis Exec=/usr/bin/qgis %F</pre> <p>But this won't work:</p> <pre>user@host:~\$ ls /usr/bin/qgis bash: /usr/bin/qgis: No existe el archivo o el directorio user@host:~\$</pre> <p>(translation: The file or directory does not exist)</p> <p>Actually there's no /usr/bin/qgis, there's a qgis.bin instead:</p> <pre>user@host:~\$ ls /usr/bin/qgis* /usr/bin/qgis.bin user@host:~\$</pre> <p>Synaptic reports that /usr/bin/qgis has been installed though (I guess I can get the same piece of information from dpkg or apt-get but I am not familiar with the syntax). I would say this is a packaging issue but I can't find a category for that. Priority could be low --the program works, as long as you execute the right binary or blocker --the average Joeubuntu could be unable to launch the program.</p> <p>Might be related to #13310 (the diversion thing). There's also a similar issue with the standalone browser.</p>
