Description

When compiling QGIS using Qt5 libraries, keyboard shortcuts - such as DEL, Ctrl+C, Ctrl+V, etc. - are not working for composer windows.

Steps to reproduce:

- 1. Launch QGIS (compiled using Qt5 libraries)
- 2. Create a new composer, and add a text item
- 3. Select that text item, and try to paste a copy of it by hitting Ctrl+C and Ctrl+V
- 4. Notice the copying / pasting doesn't work
- 5. Now try to delete the item by hitting the DEL keyboard key
- 6. Notice the deletion doesn't occur
- 7. Now try to delete the item by hitting the BACKSPACE keyboard key
- 8. Notice that actually works :)

This is obviously nothing very urgent to look into, but thought I'd file this as a reminder whenever QGIS will start moving to Qt5.
