<b>Description</b>		
<p>When compiling QGIS using Qt5 libraries, keyboard shortcuts - such as DEL, Ctrl+C, Ctrl+V, etc. - are not working for composer windows.</p> <p><b>Steps to reproduce:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Launch QGIS (compiled using Qt5 libraries)</li><li>2. Create a new composer, and add a text item</li><li>3. Select that text item, and try to paste a copy of it by hitting Ctrl+C and Ctrl+V</li><li>4. Notice the copying / pasting doesn't work</li><li>5. Now try to delete the item by hitting the DEL keyboard key</li><li>6. Notice the deletion doesn't occur</li><li>7. Now try to delete the item by hitting the BACKSPACE keyboard key</li><li>8. Notice that actually works :)</li></ol> <p>This is obviously nothing very urgent to look into, but thought I'd file this as a reminder whenever QGIS will start moving to Qt5.</p>
