<p>Every now and then, I hit an issue with the composer legend item whereas raster layer legend symbols are rendered with a static border that can't be disabled nor styled. Layout-wise, this often leads to a visual clash with the design style created by the user.</p> <p>For e.g., I've GIMPed a static border (current behavior) versus a fictive no-border alternative for a legend I'm working on ATM: http://i.imgur.com/9EORfAD.png</p> <p>IMO, the no-border alternative is much nicer.</p>
